Dr. Valaik graduated with honors from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1983 and then served as a Navy SEAL for 6 years. He went to the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences for his medical school training. He completed his Orthopaedic Residency Training at the National Naval Medical Center and did a Fellowship in Adult Reconstruction at Johns Hopkins.

Dr. Valaik comes to Johns Hopkins after 26 years of Naval Service. His last position in the military was serving as the Chief of the Orthopaedic Service at Walter Reed and the National Naval Medical Center.

Dr. Valaik was the President of the Society of Military Orthopaedic Surgeons, and is a member the Orthopaedic Trauma Association, and the Society of Medical Consultants to the Armed Forces. He is also an American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons Fellow.
